## MESSAGE FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT





Missed days add up quickly: Just two days a month puts a child's success in jeopardy because students fall behind and disconnect. By third grade, it gets much more difficult to catch up. Students who regularly miss school can quickly feel hopeless, and returning becomes harder and harder.

# SAFETY UPGRADES IN PROGRESS

#### **SEISMIC SAFETY UPGRADES at Myrtle Creek Elementary School**

South Umpqua School District has received a grant to upgrade Myrtle Creek Elementary School for safety, in the event of seismic activity. We had hoped to have all work take place over the summer months while the building was unoccupied, but have been told portions of the project will begin in the spring, and likely extend into the fall of 2020. In preparation for the work, crews will be drilling for soil samples around the school the first week of December. This will impact the parking lot and traffic flows for two days. Crews will be working closely with the school to provide updates to families throughout the construction process.

#### SECURITY UPGRADES AT ALL SCHOOL CAMPUSES

Work is also beginning at multiple school campuses to provide increased security.

Workers have begun the process of installing new doors and electronically controlled door access units. Additional security cameras are also being installed at multiple sites.
