We will be awarding scholarships to students going into teaching, criminal justice, EMT, paramedic, firefighting, and other first responder majors. Your monies will go to the college of your choice and will be designated to be used towards tuition, books/fees, and/or transportation.

If you choose the Advanced Diploma program at UCC, you will be ineligible to redeem this scholarship.

Application Information:

- Use the S.U. Common Scholarship Application and follow the directions given on the application. If the directions are not followed as specified, your application will be disqualified.
- Your social security number is optional, and no AGI is required.
- Official current high school and college transcript.
- Student may attend a two or four year school.
- Return to Mrs. Fye by 3:00 pm on Thursday, April 18, 2024.
- The Chapman Agency Helping Heroes Scholarship Committee will make selections.

Selection Criteria:

- Minimum 2.5 GPA.
- Neatness and appearance of application.
- Community Service and out of school activities will be emphasized.
- Three letters of recommendation; 1 must be from a person employed full- time at the high school, 1 outside of the school and a third one from a person of your choice. *ETS and Upward Bound are considered part of the high school.*

Remember to sign your application; it must be an original signature.

Additional Application Requirement:

- Submit a typed 250-500 word essay on "Why you want to be a first responder."
 The application and essay will be used as the basis for determining scholarship recipients.
- Submit the Activities Chart detailing your club, sport, volunteer, and work experience over the past 4 years.
