- 4. Letter of acceptance from college/trade school with a career selected within an approved trade career field (electrical, plumbing, welding, fire/EMT, construction, medical science trades). Or a letter of intent to enrollment from an accepted apprenticeship program.
- 5. Essay question, no more than 500 words. What are your future plans and what have you personally done to work toward your goals?
- 6. Essay question, no more than 500 words. What or who has inspired you to pursue a career in trades?
- 7. Three letters of recommendation from non-family members.
