South Umpqua School District is seeking volunteers for Facility Advisory Group

The South Umpqua School District is asking for volunteers to serve on its new facility advisory committee, to be formed by the school board during the September 18, 2019 work session.

Committee members will develop and recommend a long-term master plan for school buildings, including possible resources for funding. Meetings will be held once a month. Those interested should obtain an application at the district office located at 558 SW Chadwick Lane in Tri City, or on the district website at susd.k12.or.us. Completed applications must be received on or before September 18, 2019.

The board will appoint 11 members to the committee, including two persons each from Myrtle Creek, Tri City, and Canyonville; and five staff members, one from each school building. Ideally, the staff members on the committee would include an administrator, two licensed staff, and two classified staff. Attending board members will act as non-voting members of the committee; the superintendent and district facilities director will serve the committee as non-voting members.

The board has authorized HGE Inc. to provide a facility audit for the district's master facility plan, and HGE recommendations will also be considered in decisions made by the board about facilities.
