

South Umpqua Online Academy Information:

- K-5 enrollment deadline is September 2, 2021 at 4 pm. 6-12 enrollment deadline is September 10, 2021 at 4 pm. Students can join a waiting list after those dates by filling out the intent to enroll form.
- We will use Edgenuity as our online platform K-12. Edgenuity is providing the teachers and grades for our courses.
- We will have onsite staff available to help with technical assistance and course assistance.
- The time expectations for our Online Academy will be about the same as if students were onsite. Students will have a full schedule (6 classes at elementary, 7 at middle and high school)
- We are planning on starting Online Academy the same time we start onsite learning. Any changes in start date will be communicated to families.
- Parents who want to enroll their child in Online Academy need to fill out the Intent to Enroll sheet which is on the front page of our website and in each of our school offices.
- Completed forms can be returned to any school, our district office, or emailed to andy.johnson@susd.k12.or.us
- Online staff will start contacting families who enroll in Online Academy the week of August 23-27.
- Students may only enroll in Online Academy one time each year.
- High School students in Online Academy who wish to transfer back to onsite learning need to do so at a quarter or semester break.
- Chromebooks are provided for students and we may be able to help with hotspots. This information will be communicated to families upon initial contact from onsite staff.
- Attendance requirements are the same for online school as for onsite school.
