

South Umpqua Online Academy Intent to Enroll Form

The South Umpqua School District is offering an online option for students in grades 1-8 for the 2022.23 school year. The following are important points to consider as you determine whether online school would be a good option for your child:

- Courses will be taught by Oregon certified teachers employed by Edgenuity.
- Students can expect a full schedule of courses at all levels.
- The time commitment for online school is roughly equivalent to that on onsite school.
- Attendance requirements are the same for online school as they are for onsite school.
- A student may enroll in online school one time during the school year.
- SUSD will check out a computer to your child and can assist with hot spots if you do not have internet access.
- Students must remain on-track to pass all classes while in Online Academy or risk being dropped from the program.
