We are in year 3 of SEL implementation and see great progress across all school sites. Our student services team is responsive to student needs and we have the resources to provide necessary services in an efficient and effective manner. The high school has 9th grade on track practices firmly in place and we are seeing graduation rates rise.

Please share other changes you've observed outside of the progress markers; for example, any observable changes made toward your outcomes when or if they don't correspond to the progress markers:

Anecdotal information is that summer school (STEAM camps) is well liked by students, parents and staff alike. However, we are not seeing the gains in reading or math at grades K-8 that we expected. We will incorporate additional reading and math interventions next summer, as well as an additional cultural segment with our local tribal partners.

Eliminating all pay to play fees for athletics and extracurricular activities has greatly increased student participation rates. However, we now have to increase budgets for equipment purchases to accommodate increased numbers of students in these activities.
